

Signs of Suicide

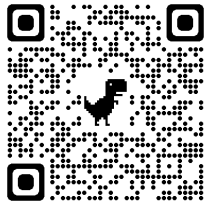

Hidden in Plain Sight

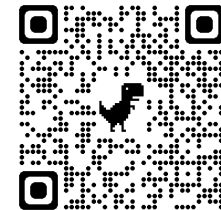

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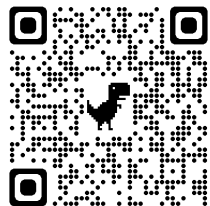
Middle School Career Fair
