District Satisfaction Survey

Fall 2019

This report contains the analysis of data gathered through the Fall 2019 District Satisfaction Survey. There were 133 respondents from a pool of 274 families (48.5% response rate).

Analysis Background:

- Five distinct categories addressed by the survey include:
 - o Administration
 - o Climate & Culture
 - o Communication
 - o Curriculum & Instruction
 - Safety & security
- A scale that asked participants to respond to statements in the following manner:
 - Strongly Agree
 - o Agree
 - Neutral / Uncertain
 - Disagree
 - Strongly Disagree
- Of the 133 respondents, 69-74 participants provided additional comments (Questions 39 & 40)
- The analysis was conducted by individual question and by grouped responses; Strongly Agree, Agree & Neutral, comparing these to Disagree & Strongly Disagree.
- Priority areas have been identified into Tier 1 and Tier 2, for the purpose of deeper analysis and potential improvement.
- Some questions appear in the analysis of more than one category as they may have implications across the five designated areas.
- The general areas indicating a need for focus are communication and administration, with averages of 19.36% and 19.63% disagreeing or strongly disagreeing with statements in these categories.

- Comments regarding curricular and extra-curricular activities were wide ranging and will be helpful as the District reviews current programming. (74 responses)
- Additional comments include a variety of topics as well. A number of these comments are consistent with the categories identifies as priority areas. (69 responses)
