Dear Mr. Ernest:

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:38-8.1 et seq., the Department of Education has verified the appropriate representation of sending district board of education members on the receiving board of education.

The Green Township School District sends 199 students to the Newton School District for grades 9 through 12. This represents 27.68 percent of the 719 students attending those grades.

Based on these data, the percentage of pupils attending Newton School District is at least 10 percent; therefore, Green Township is entitled to one representative. Since the timeline for designating the sending board of education representative to the receiving district is limited, the board of education must be prepared to designate your representative at your board meeting which is closest in time to the annual organizational meeting of the Newton School District.

A copy of 18A:38-8.2, "Representation from sending school district to board of receiving district," is enclosed for your information.
