

# 2024-25 Kindergarten Orientation: Notes from the School Nurse

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If your child stays home due to illness or personal reasons, log into Pick Up Patrol and enter those details by 8AM that day. Please be specific regarding any symptoms.



All school medications require a written doctor's order, even over-the-counter meds. The nurse is the keeper of medications in the building. Students are not permitted to have prescription or OTC meds on their person or in backpacks.

**NUT FREE CLASSROOM**



We have many students in the building with life-threatening allergies, so we strive to keep peanuts & tree-nuts out of classrooms. This means your child's snack needs to be nut-free. There are no restrictions regarding lunch, however, because there are nut-free tables available in the cafeteria.

Accidents happen! Spills at lunch, a wet slide at recess, or not getting to the bathroom in time are common reasons your child may need a change of clothes. Please keep a seasonally-appropriate set in their backpack at all times.
